## **NCSJ CHAIRMAN ISSUES STATEMENT ON MEETING WITH PRESIDENT OBAMA March 3, 2011**

Washington, D.C. – On Tuesday, March 1, NCSJ Chairman Richard Stone was part of a delegation of leaders from the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations that participated in a meeting with President Barack Obama at the White House.

During the meeting, which lasted nearly an hour, Mr. Stone had the opportunity to ask the President Obama a question about Israel, and said afterward, “I was impressed with the President’s commitment to Israel’s security and well-being. The meeting was a great exchange of ideas and a strong show of support for the Jewish community.”
